Highlighting the gist of the proposed guidelines for the conduct of online ETE for your reference:

1. General instructions for the conduct of the examination to be issued beforehand by the concerned faculty.
2. The students appearing for the ETE should ensure that they are well equipped with the system with a webcam/ camera installed in it along with screen capture/ recorder software, adequate storage space and UPS, etc.
3. To carry out a full view proctoring, students may be asked to keep the camera on and/ or to run screen capture for the entire exam duration and upload the recorded video after the exam in the gsuite folder link provided by the instructor.
4. If there is network disconnection before/during the exam, students might be asked to run screen capture software + webcam and store a recording locally, and upload the recorded video later as instructed by the instructor. Even the local webcam application can be used during the disruption of the internet while appearing in the examination.

Please note that the above-mentioned guidelines are some of the available means/ ways to conduct online ETE. I urge you to adopt the best-suited mechanism as per the convenience of both faculty colleagues and students to make the ETE successful.
